  - 20-minute lunch. **Per contract, Article 21, section B. Make sure you are getting this.**

B. Members of the Bargaining Unit shall have an uninterrupted duty-free lunch period daily of a minimum of 20 minutes. At the elementary level the lunch period shall include the time when the children are at lunch and noon recess with the exception that each member may be assigned to recess duty once per week. All assignments shall be done on an equitable basis. The remaining days shall be reserved for consultation with staff, parents and students, and activities addressing a teacher's primary responsibility.

- Make sure each teacher has their 6ft in classroom. **Should not be working with students in groups at table. All facing same direction.**
- Wellness Wednesdays. **They are not to be scheduled by administration for any reason. They are yours to use in a variety of ways YOU want. (Working with distance learning students on line, working with in person students on line, calling parents, PLCs, prepping, ...etc.)**

- o 240 minutes of prep per week. Make sure you are still getting at least 240 minutes of prep per week.
- o Clean desks. You do not have to clean ever, during class or after lunch. SEA made sure that from now on the custodians will come in your room after lunch and clean.
- o Lunch in rooms. Teachers should not be in there and class should be covered by another person during lunch. This is not your lunch period. During snack time, keep mask on and stand near door way away from students.
- o Windows open. You can open your windows to let fresh air in, just remember to not open too much when it is bellowing freezing outside.
